The program is designed to teach candidates how to analyze and evaluate investments in hedge funds, private equity, managed futures, and real assets, and how to construct portfolios comprised of both traditional and alternative assets.

CAIA is unique in that it is the only globally recognized standard of excellence and best practices within the alternative investment world. It is also unique in that study materials are updated on a regular basis to reflect current academic research and industry practices.

Success in today's complex world of alternative investments demands a strong foundation of knowledge and an unwavering dedication to professionalism.
